

RULES CHANGES SUMMARY
August 29, 2013

Partnership Program Rules

1. Clarified ranking process for unfunded Year-One projects. (6.02(iii))
2. Clarified funding priority for space, (*“warm, safe, and dry” space replacement*) and *“warm, safe and dry” (systems)* past the 2019 year. (5.05.1(ii))
3. Clarified the requirements for:
 - a. Schematics (3.30)
 - b. District submitted PORs (3.23) and (4.05.9)
 - c. Resolutions (4.05.2)
4. Clarified suitability review of single-purpose spaces built after 2008. (3.34.1) and (3.34.2)
5. Added insurance requirements contained in Insurance Rules. (5.07)
6. Added Division process to resolve application inconsistencies. (5.01.6)

Facility Manual

1. Deleted Section 1
 - a. Section 1 information better suited for website.
2. Section 2, Chapter 1
 - a. Cleaned up and eliminated language that contradicted standards in other Sections of the manual.
3. Section 2, Chapter 3
 - a. Changed grade level for career education requirement from 7th grade to 6th grade.
4. Section 2, Chapter 5
 - a. Revised POR to insert minimum sizes for single PE spaces.
 - b. Changed sizes for career education per their requests.
 - c. Added a GT space for elementary.
 - d. Changed “classroom” sizes in support spaces to 850 SF suggested sizes.
5. Section 2, Chapter 6
 - a. Removed all quantities listed for receptacles, data drops etc. that contradict with Chapter 7 requirements.
 - b. Changed footer dates to new dates.
 - c. Revised dining notes on the dining templates that contradict with the POR.
 - d. Removed wall hung water closets and floor drain requirements that contradict Chapter 7 standards.
6. Section 2, Chapter 7
 - a. Changed fire protection section to align with NFPA 72 and the Fire Prevention Code.
 - b. Changed some electrical requirements to align more with industry standards and processes.
 - c. Changed HVAC and plumbing requirements, such as ducting all instructional spaces and moving cleanout requirements from every 50’ to 100’.
 - d. Cleaned up roofing Section.
